2009 Stargazers Camp Rules and Regulations

1. Stargazers Camp hours are 8am to 1pm on Monday through Friday. Parents can drop off children as early as 7:30am and pick up children as late as 1:30pm. Make sure your registration form is complete. In case of emergency, BREC will not be responsible for lack of guardian notification due to insufficient or inaccurate information on registration form. *If any information changes during the summer, it is the parent/guardian's responsibility to make changes on the registration form.*
2. Falsifying information on the registration form could result in the child's dismissal from camp with no refund.
3. Parent/guardian *must* walk into the building each day to sign in and sign out the child. Sign-in/sign-out forms are available with the camp counselor on duty.
4. No child will be allowed to leave camp with anyone other than his/her parent/guardian without *advanced written permission from parent/guardian.*
5. We strongly discourage a child bringing money except on field trip day. All activities are paid with the registration fee. BREC is not responsible for lost money, games or other personal items brought to Stargazers Camp.
6. Camp staff is not allowed to dispense any medication to campers except basic first aid. The child is responsible for taking his/her own medicine. Parent/guardian *must* notify Observatory Manager and Camp Director of child taking medicine. Medicine must be labeled clearly with child's name, name of medication and dosage level.
7. Drop-off/pick-up times will be strictly enforced. Abuse of early drop-off/late pick-up can result in child's dismissal from Stargazers Camp. For any unforeseen problem affecting this policy parent should contact camp staff immediately with explanation.
8. BREC considers attending camp a privilege and will not tolerate unruly or disruptive behavior from any of its campers. If any child becomes a discipline problem, he/she may be subject to dismissal from camp. Parents/guardians are expected to work with camp staff in the discipline of their children. Depending on the severity of the incident, a camper can (a) be given a verbal warning, (b) be placed in time-out, (c) have an activity taken away, (d) be dismissed from Stargazers Camp.
9. Campers must be prepared to spend most of a rocket launch outside in the Sun. We recommend each camper bring a water bottle, hat, sunglasses and sunscreen that are labeled with his/her name.
10. Campers must have lunches each day that do not require refrigeration. Water and juice are preferred over carbonated drinks. No chewing gum or gummy candies allowed.
