 - a. Resolved, that the Commission approve an ordinance in accordance with LA RS 47:2201 declaring Alexander Street Park to be obsolete and authorizing the Superintendent to sell this property at no less than its appraised value of

\$550,000.00, subject to all required legal reviews. Proceeds from the sale shall be reinvested in parks and recreation facility improvements within the same service area.

- b. Resolved, that the Commission approve an ordinance in accordance with LA RS 47:2201 declaring Belfair Park to be obsolete and authorizing the Superintendent to sell this property at no less than its appraised value of \$30,000.00, subject to all required legal reviews. Proceeds from the sale shall be reinvested in parks and recreation facility improvements within the same service area.
- c. Resolved, that the Commission approve an ordinance in accordance with LA RS 47:2201 declaring Blueberry Street Park to be obsolete and authorizing the Superintendent to sell this property at no less than its appraised value of \$125,000.00, subject to all required legal reviews. Proceeds from the sale shall be reinvested in parks and recreation facility improvements within the same service area.

Resolved, that the Commission approve an ordinance in accordance with LA RS 47:2201 declaring Fortune Addition Park to be obsolete and authorizing the Superintendent to sell this property at no less than its appraised value of \$700,000.00, subject to all required legal reviews. Proceeds from the sale shall be reinvested in parks and recreation facility improvements within the same service area.

Resolved, that the Commission approve an ordinance in accordance with LA RS 47:2201 declaring Lanier Drive Park to be obsolete and authorizing the Superintendent to sell this property at no less than its appraised value of \$250,000.00, subject to all required legal reviews. Proceeds from the sale shall be reinvested in parks and recreation facility improvements within the same service area.

Resolved, that the Commission approve an ordinance in accordance with LA RS 47:2201 declaring outparcel Lot 119, 0.27-acre at 9142 Corlett Drive (Sharon Hills Park) to be obsolete and authorizing the Superintendent to sell this property at no less than its appraised value of \$25,000.00, subject to all required legal reviews. Proceeds from the sale shall be reinvested in parks and recreation facility improvements within the same service area.

Resolved, that the Commission approve an ordinance in accordance with LA RS 47:2201 declaring Wenonah Street Park to be obsolete and authorizing the Superintendent to sell this property at no less than its appraised value of \$6,000.00, subject to all required legal reviews. 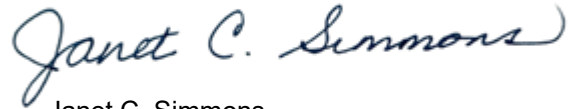
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amount was for \$40,000; subject to legal review.
