SCOTLANDVILLE GREENWAY PHOTOGRAPHY COMPETITION

BREC is planning an art installation along the Scotlandville Greenway between Badley Rd. and Wilbur St. We have received an AARP Community Challenge grant, which provides grant funding for "quick action projects" that make communities more "livable for people of all ages."

BREC has been doing work along the Scotlandville Greenway for the past year, and as part of this work, we are installing new maps and wayfinding signage along the length of the greenway. In addition, we would like to install photographs of important people and places within Scotlandville as part of this grant.

The success of this process depends on students! The task is to find an older adult in the community to work with to tell a story with a photograph. This photograph could represent an important historical place, or it could be of a person that has had historical importance within the community-whether that is your grandmother, a community leader, or a business owner.

How to enter: To submit your photo(s), email them to <u>greenways@brec.org</u>. Please submit photos in the form of a jpeg, each can be no larger than 3MB. Be sure to include "AARP Photo Contest Entry" in the subject and include the following information in the body of the email:

- First and Last Name
- Phone number
- Student email address (this is how we will contact you to confirm your entry)
- Physical address
- Photo title
- Photo location
- Date photo taken
- Print size (see print sizes on last page)
- Category of entry
- A brief description of the Scotlandville Elder you worked with and why this person or place is important (300-500 words)

RULES

How to Enter: The contest is open to current Southern University, BRCC, and Scotlandville Magnet High School students. Each contestant may enter a total of 6 different photographs. The contest is free to enter. All photos must be submitted no later than midnight, February 10, 2023, via email. Please send to greenways@brec.org with all the required information listed above. If you do not include all the required information your submission may not be accepted. You will receive a confirmation email once your photo and information has been reviewed. By submitting your photo, you are agreeing to all contest rules and guidelines. Your photograph must be submitted in digital format, preferably a JPEG, under 3MB. If your photo is selected, you will be asked to submit a high-resolution photo that can be blown up to the print size you chose without pixilation (see sizes on last page). You may enter up to 3 photographs in either category. Photos with copyrights, text, or watermarks on them will not be accepted for any category.

Judging: Photo entries will be judged based on creativity, quality, originality, and overall impact. Wining artwork will be chosen by a panel of project stakeholders. Judges will be provided the photograph, title, category of entry, and description, to ensure an unbiased selection. The judging panel will choose the top 3 finalists for each category and the overall grand prize winner to have their work featured within the park.

Prizes:

One Grand Prize Winner: \$1500
First place in each category: \$1000
Second place in each category: \$500
Third place in each category: \$250

Honorable Mention: \$100






