Even though it feels like winter, the BREC team is already hard at work planning for our award-winning summer camps. Mark your calendars now for March 4, 2023, when registration opens for residents of East Baton Rouge Parish. No matter where the camp is located. it will provide heavy doses

of Vitamins D and N (nature), opportunities to create new friendships as well as healthy activity and memorable experiences. Be on the lookout for a separate summer camp guide outlining the many different options for your children in February.

This guide focuses on all of the different programs and events we are offering you, your family and friends through both winter and spring. As I read through the guide, I couldn't help but notice how many opportunities there are to learn something new. BATON ROOTS COMMUNITY FARM THE WALLS PROJECT

Baton Roots Community Farm is located in BREC's Howell Community Park, in the middle of a food desert, through a partnership with the Walls Project and the Mayor's HealthyBR Initiative. The farm blends access to fresh food, skill-development, socialization and art into one location. Baton Roots Community Farm brings an opportunity for the East Baton Rouge Parish community to learn best practices in sustainable agriculture on an urban farm.

BATON ROUGE GALLERY. A BREC FACILITY

Baton Rouge Gallery – center for contemporary art (BRG) facility, is housed in BREC's historic City-Brooks Community Park. The non-profit art gallery hosts new monthly contemporary exhibits featuring professional artists with an opening reception on the first Wednesday of each month. BRG also offers a wealth of cultural programming that brings visitors face-to-face with contemporary art across disciplines including film, poetry, dance and more.

BATON ROUGE SOCCER CLUB

Through a successful cooperative endeavor agreement, BREC and Baton Rouge Soccer Club have been able to offer quality soccer facilities and programming to the Greater Baton Rouge Area. BRSC has developed and implemented high quality recreational programs for youth of all ages, premier soccer for the player who seeks high-level competition, assessable soccer for people with disabilities, and adult leagues for men and women from age 19 to senior citizen. BREC has developed, built, and maintained first class dedicated soccer facilities at the 22 field Burbank Soccer Complex, and the seven field Independence Park Complex, With over 6,500 members, BRSC and BREC have been the recognized leaders in the expansion of soccer as the fastest growing team sport in the Baton Rouge community.

BOYS + GIRLS CLIIR

BREC's Alaska Street Park is home to a Boys and Girls Club after-school program that promotes academic success, character and leadership, and healthy living in youth ages 7-18.

CENTRAL AREA YOUTH LEAGUE

Through a cooperative endeavor agreement, BREC and Central Area Youth League (CAYL) offer quality baseball and soccer facilities and programming to the Central Area at BREC's Central Sportsplex.

FIRST TEE

The First Tee uses the game of golf to teach youth life lessons and leadership skills. Sessions include a fun, group setting for youth ages 7 to 18 regardless of background or previous experience. Teaming up with experts in positive youth development, The First Tee helps youth become good golfers and even better people.

FRONT YARD BIKES

BREC's Terrace Street Park is home to Front Yard Bikes, an amazing organization that offers safe, free after-school programs that teach and develop hands-on skills in math, physics, mechanics, and much more while also promoting inclusivity, mentorship, recreation and academic achievement. Front Yard Bikes' programs are motivated by compassion for kids from low-income families that are willing to work for what they get.

GARDERE INITIATIVE

The Gardere Initiative, located adjacent to BREC's Hartley-Vey Gardere Park, provides children and families throughout the Gardere Community with fundamental services and resources that are otherwise unavailable to them through spiritual intervention, local partnerships, and selfless volunteering. The Gardere Initiatives works closely with BREC to hosts different events and activities within BREC's Hartley-Vey Gardere Park for residents of the Gardere Community. BREC also provides free internet services for participants enrolled in Gardere Initiative programs and activities.

KNOCK KNOCK CHILDREN'S MUSEUM

Knock Knock Children's Museum, located in City-Brooks Community Park, opens doors to the exciting world of early learning, discovery and hands on exploration through specific activities woven through 18 unique Learning Zones. Designed for children age 0 to 8, the museums Learning Zones create "teachable moments" that connect children's every day experiences to learning.

TEAM SPORTSPLEX

Team Automotive Group, the Baton Rouge Basketball and Volleyball Association (BBRVA) and BREC partnered to build a 30,000 square-foot recreational complex in the heart of Perkins Road Community Park. It is the largest indoor basketball facility in Baton Rouge and the largest indoor volleyball facility in Louisiana. It is also used for BREC summer camps, cheerleading competitions and recreation activities for seniors

The fairgrounds at BREC's Airline Highway Park can accommodate an event of up to 10,000 people. BREC's two outdoor stadiums are also available for civic or sporting events. Memorial Stadium, located at 1750 Foss St., has a seating capacity of 21,395. Olympia Stadium, located at BREC's Perkins Road Park at 7122 Perkins Road, has a seating capacity of 6,000. Independence Café and Training/Banquet Center holds up to 60 attendees and has been used for wedding receptions, meetings and trainings.

Center, 8133 Jefferson Hwy.; Greenwood Community Park's waterfront amphitheater and meeting room with stage, 13350 Hwv 19 in Baker, LA; or the wild uniqueness of the Capital One Pavilion at BREC's Baton Rouge Zoo. 3601 Thomas Road. Food and beverage services as well as kitchen facilities are available.

PAVILION RENTALS

All BREC parks are still first-come, first-serve for picnic pavilion usage. Since BREC park sites are in high demand, park users can now rent a pavilion. Renting a picnic pavilion allows the patron(s) to secure space when preparing a party, family reunion or association gathering at the park. If you rent a pavilion, then there is no reason to go to the park to "hold" your tables and pavilion ahead of time. The site will be clean and ready upon your arrival.

Each pavilion rental includes one auxiliary permit for use of dry inflatable, canopy/tent, or cooking apparatus. Auxiliary item and pavilions rental restrictions will be discussed at time of rental. If you are not renting a pavilion or want to add an additional auxiliary item, it is a \$10 non-refundable fee. Pavilion rentals may be requested on-site for small groups.

- Inflatable Rental Company must have BREC listed as co-insured with \$1 million liability coverage; a copy of the insurance policy must be included with the application.
- All Reservation must be done 14 days in advance
- \$100 separate refundable damage deposit check is required for all pavilion rentals.

Groups of 30 to 500 must have a pavilion rental agreement or apply for a special event permit. Large groups coming to enjoy one of our BREC parks must request permission 30 days in prior to the requested date. A non-refundable application fee of \$10 will apply for special event permit. Price and requirements for an approved special event is quoted within 15 days after submitting the application.

Groups of 500+ in size shall be limited to the following locations:

BREC's Airline Hwy Fairgrounds, Zachary Community Park or Highland Road Community Park (Grand Pavilion and Great Lawn) unless prior permission is granted to hold the event. Renter must come into the main office on Florida Blvd. to reserve these facilities.

Park rules will be enforced by the local Police Department, East Baton Rouge Sheriff's Department & BREC Park Rangers.
